Martin Arnold continues to work on his research on ,The way nonviolent practice works: Core Concepts of dealing with conflict in an intercultural comparison" where he studies the concepts of nonviolence of Gandhi, Goss-Mayr and others.

Barbara Mueller and Christine Schweitzer organised together with the Federation for Social Defence a workshop on Civilian-based Defence in April 2005. The documentation of that workshop contains among others articles written by Theodor Ebert, Francesco Tullio and Emanuel Matonde.

Achim Schmitz is preparing a Ph.D on trainings in nonviolence, and Reinhard Eismann on the German Civil Peace Service.

Aside from these research projects, other activities of the IFGK are so-called 'study days' held usually twice a year where researchers are invited to present their ongoing work; evaluations, support in strategic planning for NGOs, and courses given by some of its members at universities.
